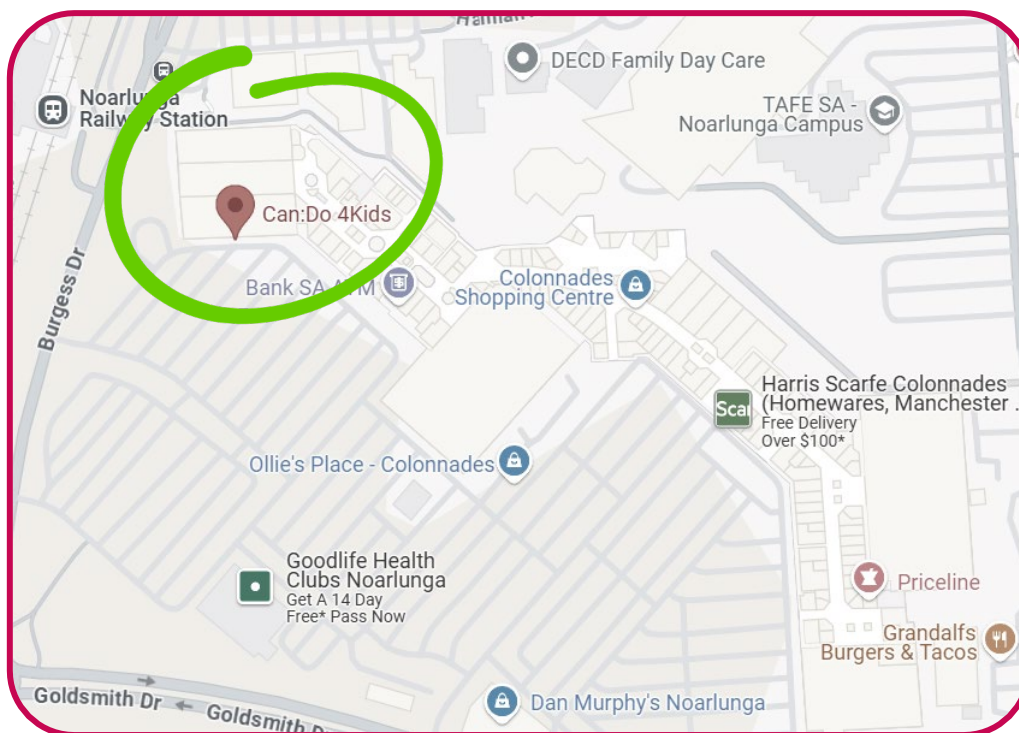


Access Guide: Can:Do 4Kids Noarlunga

Where to Find Us

Address: Lot 54 Beach Rd, Noarlunga Centre SA 5168

Located at Colonnades Shopping Centre via the Burgess Drive entrance



What You'll See:

- You'll enter through the doors leading from the zebra crossing
- Look for Can:Do 4Kids signage
- Our intercom is used to enter and is located to the right-hand side of the doors

Step-by-Step Access Directions

1. **Arrive via Burgess Drive** and park near the **Can:Do 4Kids** entrance.
2. Walk toward signs for **Can:Do 4Kids**.
3. Press the intercom button and a member of our team will ask you the reason for your visit and then open the doors for you to enter.
4. If you need help, go to the Colonnades Information Desk or use **BindiMaps** (see below).
5. Our team will be ready to greet you at the reception desk.



BindiMaps: Find Your Way with Confidence

We use **BindiMaps**, a free indoor navigation app designed to support people who are blind, have low vision, are neurodivergent, or just prefer step-by-step support when visiting unfamiliar places.



What is BindiMaps?

BindiMaps works like GPS but indoors. It uses spoken directions, large print visual maps, and on-screen arrows to help you find your way confidently.

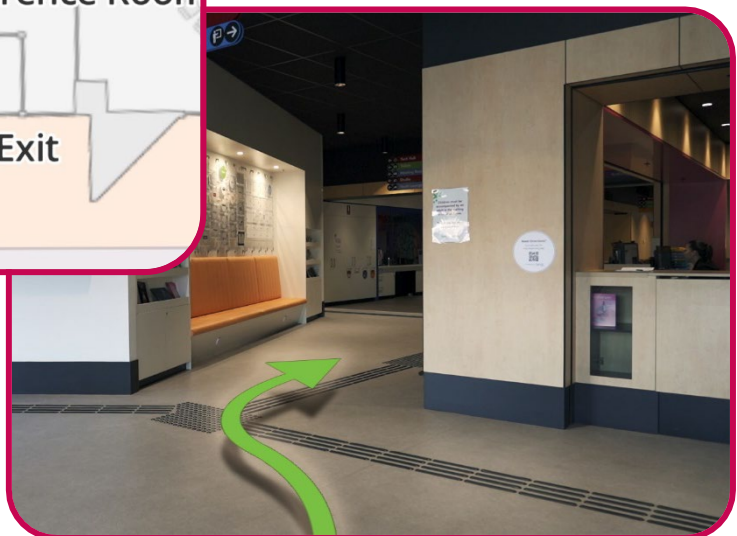
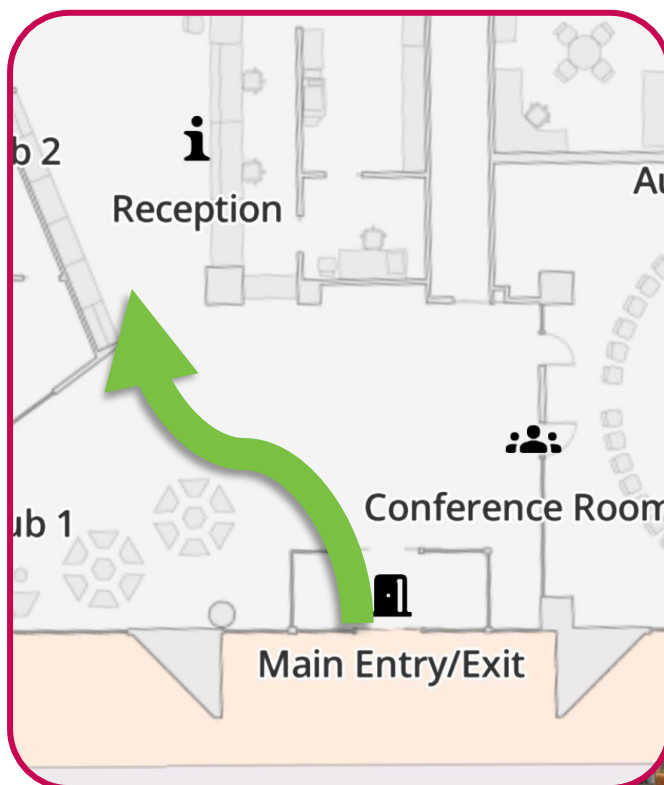
How to Use It

1. **Download BindiMaps** from the App Store or Google Play prior to attending.
Alternatively, scan the QR code or search app store to download the app.
2. **Open the app** when you arrive at Colonnades.
3. **Follow the instructions** to find Can:Do 4Kids and other key areas (like toilets and exits).

Finding Reception Desk Inside

The reception desk is not immediately visible when you arrive.

Follow directions below or directions on BindiMaps to reach it.



What to Expect Inside

We aim to create a **calm, sensory-aware** space:

Feature	What You'll Notice
Lighting	Warm and natural dimmable lights; no harsh lights. Overhead visual flashing alerts may be present when someone rings the doorbell or in an emergency evacuation for deaf community
Noise Levels	Quiet environment with minimal loud or sudden sounds due to acoustic ceiling tiles. occasional unexpected noise from other centre visitors may occur
Smells	Low-fragrance, non-scented environment. Toilets have floral fragrances
Toilets	Accessible toilets nearby. Blue toilet water.
Waiting Spaces	Low-sensory environment and quiet seating areas available
Seating	A mix of soft, firm, and armless seating
Assistance Animals	Welcome throughout the site

Support options available

We can provide extra support based on your preferences:

- ☐ Visual walkthrough or preview on Bindi maps
- ☐ Sensory-friendly waiting area (see following page)
- ☐ Braille or large print information at front entrance and amenity
- ☐ Tactile ground surface indicators for wayfinding
- ☐ Staff trained in deaf awareness
- ☐ Visual flashing alerts for emergency evacuations for deaf community



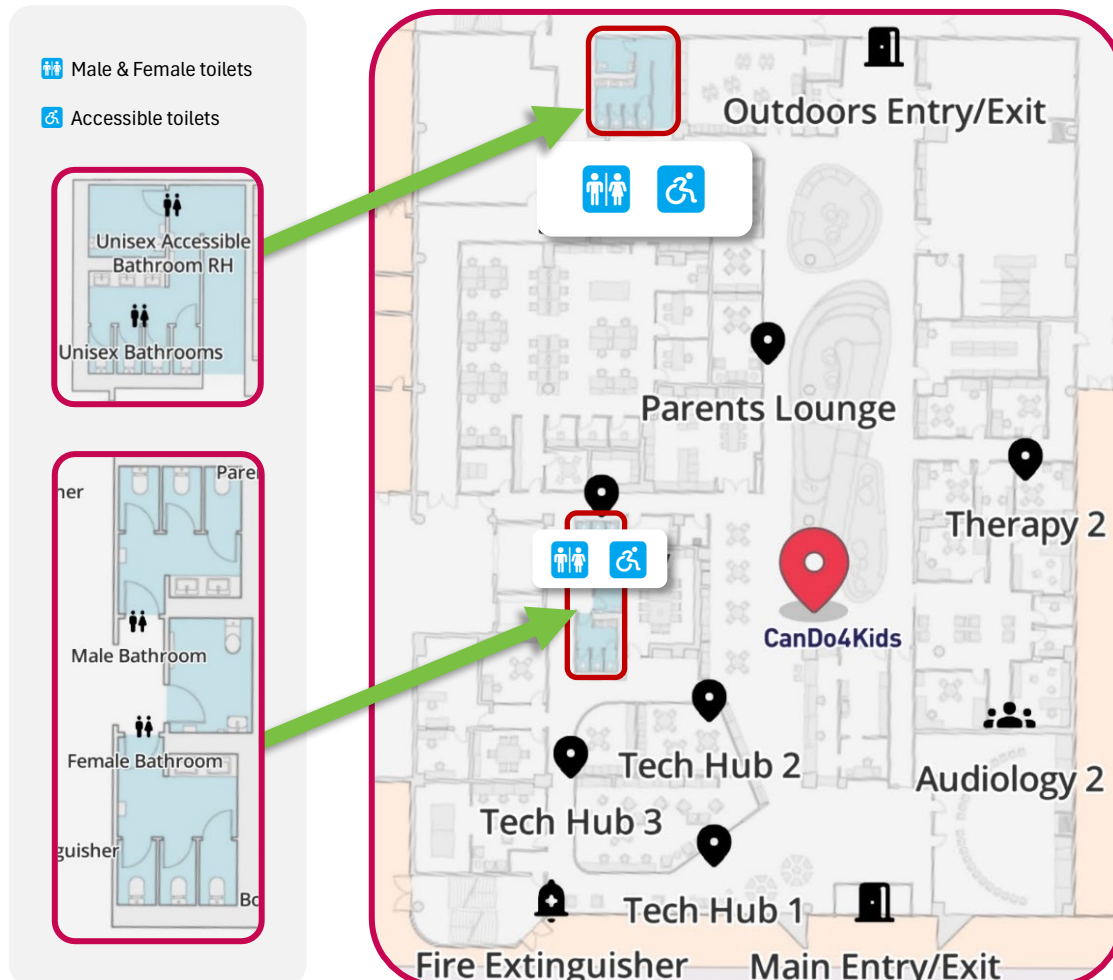
Sensory-friendly waiting area

Sensory-friendly waiting areas are available past reception where you can participate in low-sensory quiet activities or movement based sensory regulation activities.

Accessibility

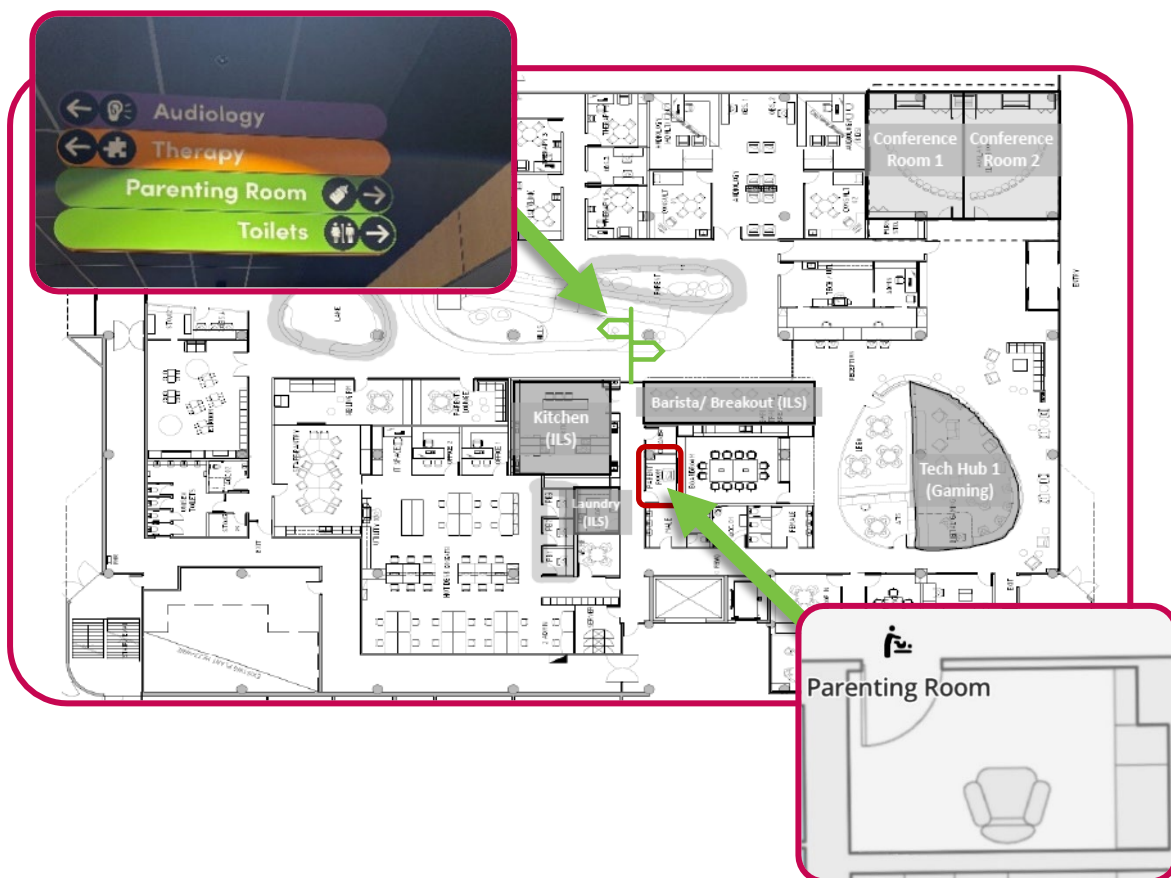
We are committed to accessibility to meet the needs of our community such as:

Parent Room Facilities
