- Provide experiences to clients that may be difficult to access without the support offered by allied health therapists
- Provide access to accessible resources and technology for clients to participate in sessions focusing on high-interest topics
- Provide the opportunity for social connections with peers also accessing our services
- Provide 'real world' practice for clients to use their assistive tech/supportive devices for purposes that are meaningful to them (eg Braille note, magnifiers, CCTV, Rogers)
- Provide an age-appropriate and engaging environment that encourages clients to develop their social, co-operative and communication skills

About RoboTech

To assist clients to access robotic technology resources and learning experiences in a supportive environment. Children with sensory needs may miss out on inclusive STEM-based experiences at school due to lack of appropriate supports, or modified resources and modes of access (for example, Braille Lego Instructions).

Parents/caregivers are required to sign their child in at the start of the session. Participants attend the sessions independently from their parents/caregivers, unless 1:1 support is required. Parents are encouraged to use our kitchen and lounge facilities if they wish to stay close by.
