#### Location

Can:Do 4Kids, Noarlunga. Located at Colonnades Shopping Centre, best parking is the Coles carpark entry off Burgess Drive.

Age 9 - 13, Wednesday, 29th September, 2021, 9:30am - 3:00pm

#### Goals of the group:

- Provide an age-appropriate and engaging environment that encourages participants to develop their social, co-operative and communication skills.
- Provide support for participants to develop skills including the ability to:
- Initiate and maintain interactions with peers
- Navigate turn taking and team work in structured and unstructured activities
- Engage in conversations with peers around shared interests
- Manage differing opinions during team based activities
- Practise community and independent living skills by going to the shops, preparing and cooking lunch with their peers

#### **About the Social Buddies session**

Participants will have the opportunity to engage in a range of activities throughout the day and practise navigating social situations in unstructured and structured settings.

Activities include:

- Use of our state-of-the-art interactive Valo climbing wall and movement zone
- Scavenger hunt
- Shopping for ingredients, cooking (and eating) a homemade pizza
- Art/craft
- Digital gaming such as Mario Cart or Minecraft

#### What to bring:

Please bring a drink bottle, and a snack if you think your child will get hungry.

#### Parents/caregivers

Participants attend the sessions independently from their parents/caregivers. Safe participation will require that your child has the ability to communicate in and understand sentences, ask for help and stay with the group when going off-site.

If there are sensory needs/considerations to support your child please inform the Can:Do team prior to the group.

#### **Funding**

This program can be funded through your NDIS plan or as a fee for service charge.

#### Staff

This program has been designed with input from a Speech Pathologist. The group will be facilitated by Allied Health Therapists with support from a Youth Workers, and/or Allied Health Therapy Assistants.
