### Goals of the group:

- Enable more engagement for clients who have a diagnosis of ASD or are deaf or hard of hearing
- Provide an age-appropriate and engaging environment that encourages clients to develop their social, co-operative and communication skills
- Development of fine and gross motor skills through activities i.e. finger dexterity, spatial awareness, visual motor integration, sequencing and tactile skills
- Development of cognitive skills i.e. attention and concentration, concept formation and problem-solving
- Development of social and emotional skills i.e. working with others, team-building skills, time-management and coping skills
- Development of language skills i.e. planning, editing narratives and communication

## About Digital Gaming

This programs is designed to provide activities where language is not a barrier, to enable more engagement for clients who have a diagnosis of ASD or are deaf or hard of hearing, provide social opportunities for children and young people, and provide an age-appropriate and engaging environment that encourages clients to develop their social, co-operative and communication skills
